Consciousness Program Facilitator (part-time)

The Baton Rouge Youth Coalition seeks a hardworking, passionate, and highly effective educator to serve as our part-time Consciousness Programs Facilitator, who will lead weekly programs with our Sophomore Fellows focused on communication.

Baton Rouge Youth Coalition Overview

BRYC is an after-school program that prepares high-achieving, under-resourced high school students to enter, excel in, and graduate from college so they can become full participants in society. We offer programming to our students between 5:00-8:00pm, Monday through Thursday, and on weekends as needed. Our programs run from the beginning of August through the end of May.

Position Overview

With support from BRYC's full-time Director of Writing, the Consciousness Programs Facilitator will lead dynamic workshops aimed at helping our Sophomore Fellows build verbal and written communication skills while analyzing important current and historical social issues. The Facilitator's primary responsibility will be to teach a total of two 90-minute programs per week – Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 5-6:30pm for a total of 3 hours of instruction per week for 12 weeks throughout the spring semester. The Facilitator will be required to attend facilitation and content training in January, arrive at least 20 minutes before each program begins, and assist with the execution of the program's end-of-semester demonstration and celebration. For these and other planned extra hours, BRYC will compensate the Facilitator accordingly.

Ideal Candidate

The ideal candidate is exceptionally hardworking and passionate about helping young people become more effective writers and speakers as they grapple intellectually with key social issues. The ideal candidate is an engaging facilitator capable of fostering a safe, fun, and productive atmosphere, and a diligent and creative planner who is excited about helping bring a new program to life. The ideal candidate is effective at building student relationships that are characterized by genuine care and high expectations. Finally, the ideal candidate is persistent and resourceful, stopping at nothing to ensure Fellows have access to top-level services even in the face of resource constraints.

Qualifications

The Consciousness Programs Facilitator should either be working on or hold a bachelor's degree at minimum and possess:

- A track record of facilitating engaging dialogue in an organized setting
- A track record of building strong, healthy relationships with high-school-age youth
- A keen interest in and command of social justice issues
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- Proficiency with Microsoft Office and Google Drive applications

Compensation

The Consciousness Programs Facilitator will earn \$20-\$25 per hour, depending on experience and qualifications. She/he/they will work about 36 hours over 12 instructional weeks over the course of the Spring Semester.
