## Academic Tutors

*The Baton Rouge Youth Coalition (BRYC) seeks intelligent, empathetic, and deeply committed college students and/or professionals to serve as tutors who work with Fellows to help them with high school classes and the ACT. Potential volunteers should be proficient in at least one subject area in high school coursework, such as geometry, chemistry, or French. We have a special need for tutors in the STEM areas.*

### **BRYC Overview**

Founded in 2009, BRYC is an after-school program that prepares high-achieving, under-resourced high school students – called “Fellows” – to enter, excel in, and graduate from college so they can become full participants in society.

### **Tutoring Program Overview**

BRYC tutors work 1-on-1 with BRYC Fellows who require additional assistance in their high school coursework. This can involve studying for a test or the ACT, explaining a difficult homework problem, or helping prepare a project. Tutors are scheduled through our appointment scheduling system. This allows Fellows to work 1-on-1 with a content area expert. Tutoring hours are Monday through Thursday between the hours of 4-8 pm.

### **BRYC's Support of Tutors**

- BRYC designates two full-time staff members to oversee the tutoring program and provide support: the director of learning and the ACT learning manager.
- Tutors will receive updates about Fellows who request tutoring through the appointment system.
- Additional support for scheduling volunteer hours will come from the ACT learning manager.
- BRYC provides reference materials and practice problems on-site.

### **Baseline Expectations**

- Desire to educate and help Fellows achieve mastery of their material
- Communicate with ACT learning manager if any problems arise
- Commit to showing up at BRYC for at least one hour every week at a consistent day/time

### **Qualifications**

- Experience working effectively with youth
- High levels of empathy and patience
- Ability to explain mathematical, graphical, grammatical, or rhetorical concepts
- Punctuality and dependability
- **Nice-to-have:** Prior educational experience (teacher, tutor)
